Contract for Honors/AP Classes Please bring this completed contract to your one-on-one counselor meeting.

Students are encouraged to take the most appropriately challenging schedule while being conscious of what is required. As such, students (and their parent/guardian) who wish to register for <u>3 or more Honors or</u> Advanced Placement (AP) courses must sign the following contract.

- 1. I recognize that participation in Honors and AP classes requires me to:
 - demonstrate increased student independence,
 - take on a high degree of responsibility, and
 - meet higher standards than students in College Preparatory courses to earn the same grade. Note: Students should expect that the amount of homework for these classes is commensurate with the level; students should attend Honors and AP Informational Meetings to learn course expectations.
- 2. I intend to remain enrolled in the Honors and AP classes I have chosen for the duration of the course. While transfers to a College Preparatory/Honors class may be granted, the following policy will be applied:
 - There is no guarantee that there will be space available in College Preparatory/Honors classes for students who want to drop Honors/AP classes.
 - When transferring, a student's grade will follow them into the new non-Honors or non-AP course.
 Please note, level changes must take place by the end of the 11th week of class.
 - Students who drop an Honors/AP course after the first ten days of the semester will receive a W (Withdraw) on their transcripts. Courses dropped after 11 weeks will result in a WF (Withdraw Fail).
- 3. I agree to uphold the school's policy on academic honesty. I have reviewed the academic honesty policy in the Student and Parent Handbook.
- 4. I understand that taking more than one Honors/AP course could significantly impact my workload and I have carefully considered my overall schedule and time commitments, including downtime and sleep.
- 5. I have marked the 3 or more Honors/AP courses on the back side of this form that I plan to enroll in next year.

In advance of completing this contract, we recommend you use the Challenge Success Time Scheduling Worksheet to anticipate your average week's responsibilities and anticipated time for sleep, extracurriculars, friends, and family.
